The Comprehensive Restructuring of Belleville High School

As the educational leader of Belleville High, an urban high school of nearly 2,000 students, I coordinated the strategic planning and execution of comprehensive academic restructuring. In concert with an administrative team of six and a faculty of 101, our restructuring focused on three key areas: curriculum and instruction, assessments and outcomes, and building climate and safety. The outcomes in each reform area were dramatic: BHS achieved Adequate Yearly Progress for the first time, improved core area standardized test scores, diminished student and staff absenteeism, and enjoyed improvements across all measures of school climate.



The progress made during my 5-year administrative tenure continues through today. The improved academic outcomes and decreased incidents of violence, suspensions, and drugs and alcohol contributed to staff longevity and wider community support. In 2008, the community passed a \$79 million bond proposal construct a new school after previous attempts failed. Once one of the lowest performing schools in western Wayne County, BHS continues its upward trajectory with students reaping the rewards.
